# 2017 FEES SCHEDULE

## SUBJECT LEVIES

- Subject levies are charged to offset the additional expense and resource-heavy nature of specific subjects, such as Art, Materials Design and Technology, Food Technology and Outdoor Education. **The elective subjects offered are subject to change at any time.**
- Any students transferring into or out of an elective subject **before** the School Curriculum and Standards Authority deadline in Semester 1 or 2, will incur charges of, or be refunded 100% of the subject cost, whichever is applicable.
- All students in Year 11 who commence a Certificate course will be charged a \$150 additional course fee. This is to assist the College with the cost of the additional resources and auspicing costs associated with these courses. The fee was outlined in the Year 11 Handbook presented to students at the parent information evening.

- Payment of the Building Fund Donation is entirely voluntary. The suggested amount is provided as a guide only. A voluntary contribution of a different amount can also be made. A tax deductible receipt will be forwarded for any donation provided.

## DISCOUNTS

Families with more than one child at the College receive discounts on tuition fees, per annum, as outlined below:

- All students and families are eligible for sibling discounts including families who receive automatic tuition fee discounts as holders of eligible means tested family concession cards.
- Any applicable discounts for multiple children will be applied to the child in the lowest year level.

## SPLIT BILLING

Families who wish to split their account equally between two parties must provide written advice to the College, signed by both parties, authorising the account to be divided equally. The authority should be returned to the Finance Office by 3 March 2017.





# 2017 FEES SCHEDULE

## PAYMENT OPTIONS

Families **must select one of the following options** for the payment of per student Tuition Fees, Levies and other per family annual charges of the Yearbook, Building Levy and FOSL Levy. All Year 12 fees, levies and charges **must be finalised by the end of Term 3** (22<sup>nd</sup> September 2017).

### Option 1

Payment of all fees, levies and charges in FULL in one instalment by **14 April, 2017**. This option is available via direct debit or credit card. Alternatively, payment may be made by cash, cheque or by direct deposit into the College bank account.

### Option 2

Payment of fees, levies and charges in three (3) instalments, due on **15 March, 15 June and 15 September, 2017**. This option is available via direct debit from bank accounts using the Direct Debit Scheme or by providing the College with your credit card details for automatic payment on the dates specified. In addition, payment may be made by cash.

### Option 3

Payment of fees, levies and charges in nine (9) equal instalments, due on the **15 March and each month thereafter through to 15 November 2017**. This option is only available via Direct Debit from bank accounts using Direct Debit Scheme or by providing the College with your credit card details for automatic payment on dates specified.

### Option 4

Payment of fees, levies and charges in eighteen (18) equal instalments, due on **15 March and fortnightly thereafter through to 18 November, 2017**. This option is only available via direct debit from bank accounts using the Direct Debit Scheme or by providing the College with your credit card details for automatic payment on dates specified.

### Option 5

Payment of fees, levies and charges in 36 equal weekly instalments, due on **15 March and weekly thereafter through to 15 November, 2017**. This option is ONLY available via direct debit payment plan.

## HEALTH CARE CARD SCHEME

The discounted tuition fee covers tuition fees only to a limit of \$1,400 and does not cover additional charges such as the Friends of St Luke's Fee, Compulsory Building Levy, Voluntary Building Fund donation and camps, book hire, excursions, etc.

To access the Health Care Card Tuition Fees Discount Scheme:

- Parents/Guardians will need to show a valid Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card.
- Applications close – 1 April 2017.
- Holders of cards that are due to expire prior to the end of Term 3 will need to show their new card once issued for the discounts to continue.
