**Prospective Parents' Night Term 1**

The family interview is the first important step in this partnership. Families meet with either the Principal or Deputy to outline why St Luke's is the school of choice for your child.

**A Day in the Life: Year 7 Term 4**

A Day in the Life: Year 7 is designed for your child to experience subjects offered at St Luke's college. Building relationships with subject teachers and future peers starts here.

**Orientation Day Term 4**

Orientation Day is the first day that your child is invited to experience St Luke's College. It is on this day your child meets their Pastoral Care Coordinator and bonds with peers in their house groups.

**Commencement of high school Year 7's First Day Jan**

The purpose of the day is to continue to build House identity and pastoral care structures within the Houses.

**Year 7 Camp Term 1**

The purpose of the Year 7 Camp experience is to bring students together and give them an opportunity to build relationships with peers and the Pastoral Care Coordinators.
